## **WOODCOCK VALLEY COMMUNITY PARK RULES**

- PAYMENT FOR PARK RENTAL IS DUE NO LATER THAN TWO WEEKS AFTER MAKING THE RESERVATION AT THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE.
- THIS PARK IS PROVIDED FOR YOUR USE AND CONVENIENCE AND FUNDED WITH YOUR TAX DOLLARS

**PLEASE NOTE:** The rental of this park is **ONLY** for the large pavilion. The rest of the outlying ball fields, play equipment, basketball court and small pavilion are available to the general public at all times. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** 

## **PLEASE:**

- 1. Leave the park as you found it.
- 2. Clean up and put refuse in the barrel provided. If cans are full, please take them to the dumpster in the lower parking lot.
- 3. CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PETS AND KEEP THEM ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES!
- 4. When a daily reservation is posted at the pavilion, please use the gazebo.
- 5. Park in parking lots only, not on the grass.
- 6. If grills are used, please make sure the fire is extinguished before disposing of contents. Clean them up and leave them as you found them.
- 7. If any damage occurs to *anything*, please report it to the Township Office as soon as possible.
- 8. If you move any tables, return them to their original place before leaving. DO NOT WALK OR WRITE ON THE TABLES.
- 9. The park closes 30 minutes after sunset and opens 30 minutes before sunrise.
- 10. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed on the premises.
- 11. NO SKATING, BIKING, SKATEBOARDING OR RIDING RECREATIONAL VEHICLES (I.E. "FOUR WHEELERS") IS PERMITTED ON THE WALKING PATH, BASKETBALL COURT OR IN THE PAVILIONS. These facilities are to be used by pedestrians only.
- 12. NO RECREATIONAL VEHICLES (I.E. "FOUR WHEELERS", ETC.) ARE PERMITTED ON PARK PREMISES.
- 13. The Township Office needs a 2 week notice when canceling pavilion reservations to refund your money. We cannot refund money due to inclement weather.
- 14. Cameras are in use at the park. Anyone caught damaging Township property will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. Children are the responsibility of their parents or guardians. Please do not allow your children to do something at the park that you wouldn't allow them to do at home.
